


Veronica de Vera is a young, multi-talented, and experienced artist who offers a wide range of services primarily focused on oil and watercolour painting commissions.



Her more recent work in 2021 has included an original painting of Senator Bernie Sanders with his internet-sensational mittens during the US Inauguration as well as the Discover Colchester illustrations, which feature in this activity book.
