TICKETS

 Please ensure tickets are downloaded prior to arrival at the gate.

TRAVEL

- Do allow ample time for your journey.
- Do plan your travel in advance for the event. Planned roadworks can cause delays. You can check for any roadworks at www.roadworks.org
- Do tune into local radio and check social media for the latest travel updates.

WEATHER

 Do check the weather and bring weather proof clothing if appropriate.

ID

 Do bring valid photographic ID (Passport, UK Driving Licence), we operate a strict 'Challenge 25, Serve 18 Policy'. Please remember that legally there is no automatic right to be served alcohol. Service is always at the discretion of the licensee.

RESPECT

- · Do be patient.
- Do arrive at the venue in good time prior to the start of the concert, there will be security checks in place.
- Do leave the event quietly and please respect our neighbours.
- · Do put any rubbish in the bins provided for you.



SAFETY & SECURITY

BAGS & VALUABLES

- Do not bring a bag if you can possibly avoid it. If you must please don't bring one larger that an A4 sheet of paper.
- Do not bring any valuables if it can be helped.

BANNED & PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Do not bring food and drink into the venue a doctor's note will permit food/drink required for medical conditions. Cups of water are available at the bars free of charge.
- Do not bring glass containers including perfume and aftershave.
- Do not bring camping chairs, folding chairs, gazebos or picnic blankets.
- Do not bring professional cameras, video cameras or audio recording devices.
- Dogs are not permitted, except assistance dogs.

RE-ENTRY

AGE RESTRICTIONS

- Children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Babes in arms are free.
- For child safety please ensure ear defenders are worn.
- All ticket holders may be asked to produce proof of age upon entry and at the bars.

SEARCHES

 Searches will be in operation at this event – bags will be searched. No bags over the size of A4 will be allowed into the arena.

BEHAVIOUR

It is our intention for you to enjoy the event. Please help us by being kind and courteous to our team and other concert goers. Aggressive and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated. If you display such behaviour you will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

GETTING HERE

IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT YOU PLAN HOW YOU GET TO THE CONCERT IN ADVANCE. THERE ARE A NUMBER OF ROAD CLOSURES AND PARKING SUSPENSIONS IN PLACE FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT DAY.

PRE PAID CONCERT PARKING

Limited parking is available at Kings Meadow (accessed via Catchpool Road, CO1 1XN) which must be purchased in advance from fatsoma.com

PARKING

The closest car parks are located at Priory Street and Leisure World, where you can access the Park via the north entrance. Further parking is available through the council's town centre car parks.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

Blue badge and disabled parking is available in the High Street and Castle Street.

TRAINS

The venue is a 10 minute walk from Colchester Town Station along Queens Street - head for the castle, the park is located just behind. Alternatively, we are a 20 minute walk from Colchester North Station.

BUS

Colchester Bus Station is located on Osbourne Street in the Town Centre and runs regular services locally and regionally. For more travel information please visit - colchester.gov.uk


EXITING

ENTRANCES

 There are two entrances. The South Entrance off Middle Mill, and the North Entrance by Leisure World

SEATING

- This event is a standing event.
- You are NOT permitted to bring camping furniture of any kind into the event.

ACCESSIBILITY

- The event takes place on grass with flat hard paths.
- Friendly stewards will be around to assist and accessible toilets will be available.
- The event area is suitable for wheelchair users with assistance.

The accessible areas are sold out, if extra space does become available this will be on a first come first served basis.

WEATHER

- The concert will not be cancelled in the event of inclement weather.
- Please me mindful of the weather and wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
- Umbrellas are permitted in the standing areas but must be taken down during the show.

TOILETS

 Standard and accessible toilets facilities are located throughout the event area.

MOBILE COVERAGE

 There may be limited phone coverage across all networks and as is often the case in large crowds, service may be unreliable.

 All bars at the event operate a fully cashless system, payments can be made with Credit or Debit cards or prepurchased tokens.

TOKENS

- If you wish to pay in cash, you will need to head to the token booth before heading to the bar.
- Please note that tokens are for drinks for the bars only and not the food outlets.

REFRESHMENTS

- You are not permitted to bring food and drink* to the event. (*unless for medical circumstances)
